COMMERCIAL TERMS

1. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** 01 January 2024
2. **PUBLISHER:** THE CHANCELLOR, MASTERS, AND SCHOLARS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD trading as [OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS of Great Clarendon Street, Oxford OX2 6DP, United Kingdom](#)
3. **NATIONAL LIBRARY: THE NATIONAL LIBRARY OF FINLAND** of [P.O. Box 15 \(Unioninkatu 36\), Helsinki University, FIN-00014, Finland](#). the Finnish National Library has central tasks for the university, polytechnic, research institutions and public libraries of Finland that form the FinELib consortium.
4. **CUSTOMER:** Each institution named in Schedule D, as amended from time to time in accordance with the terms of this Agreement (collectively, "Customers"). References to "Customer" shall be construed as a reference to each and every institution individually. The liability of each institution shall be several and not joint.
5. **PUBLICATION(S):** The Journals published online by the Publisher that are (i) listed in Schedule E as may be amended from time to time;
6. **CHARGES:** The prices set out in Schedule B as may be amended from time to time in accordance with Clauses 4.4. and 4.5.1 and Schedule B concerning, (i) access to the Publications, and (ii) publication of OA Articles in accordance with the terms of Schedule C.
7. **PAYING PARTY:** National Library
8. **TERM:** The term of this Agreement, being a period commencing on the Effective Date and expiring [2 years](#) thereafter.

THE CONSORTIUM REPRESENTS AND WARRANTS THAT IT IS AUTHORISED TO ACT AS AGENT FOR EACH AND EVERY CUSTOMER THROUGH A POWER OF ATTORNEY.

THE PUBLISHER, THE CONSORTIUM AND EACH CUSTOMER (EACH ACCEPT AND AGREE TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT, WHICH INCORPORATES THE ATTACHED SCHEDULES, EXHIBITS AND ANNEXES.

NATIONAL LIBRARY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1 COMMENCEMENT AND TERM

- 1.1 This Agreement will commence upon Effective Date and will continue thereafter for the Term, unless sooner terminated in accordance with the terms and conditions hereunder. For purposes of clarity, this Agreement will apply to (a) the product defined in Schedule E as may be amended from time to time, and (b) the publication of OA Articles (as defined below).

2 DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 In this Agreement, the following defined terms will have the following meanings:

"Authorised User"	an individual who is authorised by the Customer to access the Customer's information services available through the Customer's Secure Network, and who is (i) affiliated with the Customer as a current student, faculty, researcher, registered member and library card holder of the Customer's library, or employee or retired faculty, researcher or employee, whether from a computer or terminal on the Customer's Secure Network, or offsite to a valid IP address on the Customer's Secure Network; or (ii) physically present on the Customer's premises (walk-in-user); (iii) a former employee or outsourced member of staff who is permitted by the Customer to continue to hold ID and passwords enabling access, remote or otherwise, to the Customer's Secure Network, in their performance of services for and on behalf of the Customer only;
"Charge Request"	a request from an Eligible Author to use the OA Article Allowance to cover the charge for the publication of an OA Article
"Charges"	As defined at Charges in the Commercial Terms above.
"Commercial Use"	<p>use for the purposes of monetary reward (whether by or for the Customer, an Authorised User, or any other person or entity) whether by means of sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire, or any other form of exploitation of the Publications.</p> <p>For the avoidance of doubt, the following is not deemed to constitute Commercial Use:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• recovery of direct costs or costs required by law by the Customer from Authorised Users or from the receiving library in the case of inter library loan;• use by the Customer or Authorised User of the Publications in fee based educational programs;• use by the Customer or Authorised User of the Publications in the course of research funded by a commercial organization• nor use of the Publications as a source for, or using excerpts from it in Authorised User's own scientific, scholarly, and educational works including but not limited to books and articles.
"National Library"	as defined at National Library in the Commercial Terms above

"Customer"	as defined at Customer in the Commercial Terms above
"Customer Terms and Conditions"	the terms and conditions attached to this Agreement as Schedule A, which govern the access and use of the Publications by each Customer and its Authorised Users.
"Educational Purposes"	shall mean for the purpose of education, teaching, distance learning, private study retrieving information and/or research
"Eligible Article"	a research article, review article, brief report, or case report, in each case (i) written by an Eligible Author, (ii) accepted for publication in an Eligible Journal, and (iii) which is Received Into Production during the relevant calendar year of the Agreement. For clarity, articles in supplements (i.e. specifically designated issues supplementary to a journal's usual publication, often sponsored by third parties), are not considered to be Eligible Articles hereunder
"Eligible Author"	the corresponding author of an article who is affiliated with a Customer
"Eligible Journal(s)"	the Journal(s): (i) listed in Schedule E as being eligible journals for use of the Article Allowance as may be updated from time to time by the Publisher, and/or (ii) notified to the National Library in writing as being eligible journals
"Fully OA Journal(s)"	a Journal in which all the articles are published on an open access basis
"Hosting Fees"	the fees payable for hosting services as further described in Annex 1 to the Customer Terms and Conditions
"Hybrid Journal(s)"	a Journal in which authors can choose to publish articles on an open access basis
"Journals"	the online version of the Publisher's journals listed in (i) Schedule E
"Journals Subscription"	A purchased subscription for Journals
"Material"	any abstract, article, index, advertising, or other material contained in the Publications and accessed online
"No Open Access Journal(s)"	a Journal in which authors cannot publish articles on an open access basis
"OA Account"	Publisher's open access account(s) which allows Eligible Authors to use the OA Article Allowance in accordance with the terms of this Agreement
"OA Account Process"	Appendices 1-3 to Schedule C of the Agreement outlining the procedures for using OA Article Allowance, including how Eligible Authors may make Charge Requests, and how the Customer can manage Charge Requests. This document may be subject to change by the Publisher at any time, provided that such changes will not alter the terms of this agreement to the detriment of the Customer or Eligible Author.
"OA Article"	an Eligible Article published on an open access basis

"OA Article Allowance"	the number of articles that may be published as OA Articles in Eligible Journals in accordance with the terms of Schedule C
"OA Licence"	the Creative Commons licence used for publication by the Publisher of an OA Article
"Paying Party"	as defined at Paying Party in the Commercial Terms above
"Password(s)"	shall mean any passwords given by Publisher to the Customer to enable the Customer to access the OA Account
"Permitted Use"	for each Publication, respectively, the permitted use of that Publication, as provided in Clause 2 of the Customer Terms and Conditions
"Publications"	as defined at Publications in the Commercial Terms above
"Publisher"	as defined at Publisher in the Commercial Terms above
"Received Into Production"	the manuscript of an article has entered into the Publisher's production process after acceptance and prior to publication
"Retrieval Portal"	shall mean an information retrieval portal which enables searching of data from multiple databases;
"Secure Network"	a network (whether a stand alone network or a virtual network within the Internet, accessible offsite) which is accessible only to Authorised Users; without limitation, a cache server or any server or network which can be accessed by anyone other than Authorised Users is not a Secure Network
"Server"	either the Publisher's server or a third party server designated by the Publisher on which the Publications are mounted and through which the Customer and its Authorised Users may gain access to the Publications by means of the World Wide Web
"Subscription End Date"	31 December 2025
"Subscription Period"	for all Subscription Publications, the period commencing on the Subscription Start Date and expiring on the Subscription End Date.
"Subscription Publication"	a Publication which is purchased on a subscription basis
"Subscription Start Date"	01 January 2024
"Term"	as defined at Term in the Commercial Terms above
"Update Fees"	the fees payable for access to Updates as further described in Annex 2 to the Customer Terms and Conditions

3 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PUBLISHER

- 3.1 In consideration of the payment by the Paying Party of the relevant Charges due with respect to a given Customer, the Publisher agrees to (a) provide that Customer and its Authorised Users with access to the Publications for the relevant Subscription Period(s) in accordance with the Customer Terms and Conditions, and (b) publish OA Articles in accordance with the terms and conditions of Schedule C.

- 3.2 The Publisher reserves the right to suspend access to the Publications and/or the OA Account in the event of late payment of the Charges by the National Library and the National Library fails to pay the same within 30 (thirty) days of being given written notice to do so by the Publisher. The Publisher reserves the right to suspend access to the Publications in the event of any unauthorised use of the Publications. As far as is reasonably possible, the Publisher shall exercise the right to suspend in a manner that is appropriate to the unauthorised use, and the Publisher will aim to limit suspension to the offending ip-address where this is reasonably and practically possible. For the avoidance of doubt any such denial of access will not entitle the Customer to any rebate of Charges.
- 3.3 The Publisher agrees to make available to the National Library the monthly usage statistics that are made available to all Customers pursuant to Clause 4.2 of the Customer Terms and Conditions.

4 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONSORTIUM

- 4.1 The National Library shall, prior to the Subscription Period, provide to the Publisher the relevant access control details relating to each Customer, and the National Library shall notify the Publisher in writing of any changes to such details.
- 4.2 The National Library agrees to inform all its member institutions of the availability of the Publications once every year throughout the Term.
- 4.3 No later than 31 October in each calendar year of the Subscription Period, the Publisher shall notify the National Library of the following information applicable for the following calendar year:
- 4.3.1 the Publications that will be included in the new collection, and the Charges applicable for access to such new collection; and
 - 4.3.2 any Publications leaving the then-existing collection, and the applicable Charges for access to the then-existing collection (less any such leaving Publications). For clarity, the Charges will not be higher than stated in Schedule B.

The National Library shall confirm to the Publisher within 45 days of such notification whether each Customer is (a) upgrading to the new collection on the basis of (4.4.1) above, or (b) continuing with the existing collection (less any such leaving Publications) on the basis of (4.4.2) above.

- 4.4 The Customer may opt out from this Agreement during the Subscription Period. Notice of such a decision to opt out must be given in writing by the National Library to the Publisher no later than 30 November in each year of the Subscription Period. Following receipt of such notice by the Publisher, at the end of such year, the IP range of such Customer will be excluded and such Customer will lose access to the Publications, the Customer will no longer be able to publish OA Articles, and the Customer Agreement for such Customer will terminate. In the event of any opt out, the relevant Customer's share of the Charges will be deducted from the Charges for the next calendar years of the Subscription Period. For the avoidance of doubt, any such Customer termination shall not affect any rights and obligations of the other Customers.
- 4.5 New customers have the right to individually opt in to this Agreement throughout the Subscription Period. Notice of such a decision to opt in must be given in writing to the Publisher no later than 30 November in each year of the Subscription Period. In such event:
- 4.5.1 the corresponding Charges for access to the Publications will be agreed in accordance with the pricing calculation agreed between the Publisher and National Library, and such Charges shall be paid annually by the National Library on the Customers' behalf in accordance with clause 5.1 below;
 - 4.5.2 In consideration for payment of such Charges, the Publisher will agree to enter into a Customer agreement and all applicable schedules and annexes to this Agreement, with that new member Customer; (for avoidance of doubt, the new member Customer will have access from January 1st of the first year of their Term) and

- 4.5.3 following the National Library providing the Publisher the relevant access control details (contact details, IP ranges) relating to such new member Customer, the Publisher will provide such new member Customer with access to the Publications and, open access publishing services, with effect from 1st of January of the following year and for the remainder of the Subscription Period in accordance with this Agreement.
- 4.5.4 The parties acknowledge that 'Tampere University of Applied Sciences' and 'Tampere University including Tampere University Hospital' (both Customers), share the same IP address(es). Consequently, both such Customers are required to, as applicable and in accordance with the terms herein: upgrade to the new collection, or continue with the existing collection, and/or opt out from this Agreement, on a collective basis.

5 PAYMENT OF THE CHARGES

- 5.1 In consideration of the Publisher entering into the Customer agreements with each Customer through the National Library representing each Customer via a power of attorney, the Paying Party shall pay the Charges due to the Publisher as set out in Schedule B in each year of the Term within 60 days of receipt of each appropriate invoice. For Journals, the Publisher will invoice the National Library using separate invoices: one invoice relating to access to the Journals (i.e. 'read'); and one relating to publication of OA Articles (i.e. 'publish'). The Publisher's allocation of the Charges between 'read' and 'publish' is set out in Schedule B and is based on the Customers' subscription spend and estimated article publishing output. Such allocation may be subject to rounding up variations to a maximum of €10 (ten euros) as may be necessary due to the functionality of the Publisher's management system. Such invoices shall contain:

- 5.2 *Where the Paying Party is the National Library:* the National Library agrees to pay the Publisher the Charges irrespective of whether the National Library collects any payment from any/all of the Customers. If the National Library fails to pay such sums to the Publisher, the Publisher may suspend access to any or all Publications or any portion thereof and/or the OA Account or may terminate this Agreement without liability to the National Library or to any Customer, and the National Library and Customers, respectively, agree that the sole remedy in such circumstances would be the Customers' remedies against the National Library and not the Publisher. The Publisher's rights specified in this Clause are in addition to any rights and remedies that may be available in law or equity.
- 5.3 Subject to Clause 4.5.2, the Publisher will not be obliged to grant access to a Publication, or continue to grant access to a given Customer, if the relevant Charges have not been paid in accordance with Clause 5.1 above.
- 5.4 Unless expressly stated to the contrary in this Agreement, all amounts referred to in this Agreement shall be interpreted as being amounts exclusive of value added tax. The National Library is responsible for payment of any value added tax payable to the Finnish tax authority. The National Library shall pay all amounts due to the Publisher without any deduction and/or withholding other than such amount (if any) it is required to deduct and/or withhold by law and/or upon other direction of any tax authority. In the event the National Library is required to make such deduction and/or withholding, the National Library shall notify the Publisher promptly on becoming aware of such requirement.

6 ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND PROTECTION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- 6.1 The National Library acknowledges that, as between the Publisher and the National Library, all copyrights, patent rights, trademarks, services marks, database rights, trade secrets and other intellectual property rights relating to the Publications, and the Publisher's trademarks OXFORD, and OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS (collectively the "Publisher Intellectual Property"), are owned or controlled by or licensed to the Publisher, and the National Library further acknowledges that this Agreement does not convey to the National Library any right, title, or interest therein except for the right to access and use, and permit its Authorised Users to access and use, the Publications in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

7 ETHICAL CONDUCT

- 7.1 The National Library agrees that it is subject to and will comply with all applicable laws in Finland, including the Criminal Code of Finland which prohibits bribery and corruption, in the performance of this Agreement. The Publisher agrees that it is subject to and will comply with all applicable laws in the United Kingdom related to the prevention of bribery and corruption in the performance of this Agreement. Each party further agrees that it shall not act, or omit to act, in such a way as to give rise to a breach by it, or any of its Affiliates, of any applicable law related to bribery, corruption or any related matters.
- 7.2 The National Library shall co-operate with Publisher and/or any regulatory or public authorities in relation to any investigation in respect of matter relating to bribery and corruption arising out of this Agreement.
- 7.3 Either party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement on no notice, without liability, for breach of this Clause 7, with the exception of Clause 7.4.iii.
- 7.4 The National Library shall:
- i use reasonable efforts to maintain accurate and complete records of all expenditures related to Charges under this Agreement and make such records available to Publisher, its advisors, auditors and any regulatory or public authorities on reasonable notice;
 - ii answer, in reasonable detail, any written or oral inquiry from Publisher related to the National Library's compliance with this clause 4; and
 - iii apply the principles outlined in the OUP Partner Code of Conduct, as provided to the National Library, in the execution of the National Library's obligations under this Agreement and to the extent such principles do not contradict applicable laws in Finland. A breach of such principles by one party shall not give the other party right to any form of remedy, including but not limited to termination of this Agreement or damages.

8 TERMINATION

- 8.1 Each Customer may terminate this Agreement at any time for convenience provided that no refund of any payments shall be due. When the Agreement is terminated the respective Customer's share of the Charges will be deducted from the Charges.
- 8.2 If a party commits a material breach of this Agreement (and in the case of a breach capable of remedy fails to remedy the same within 30 days of a formal written request from the other party to do so), then the other party may terminate this Agreement with immediate effect by giving the breaching party formal written notice of termination. Termination of this Agreement by the Publisher due to a breach by the Paying Party of Clause 5.1 above, or the Customer of Clauses 2.3 and 3.3 of the Customer Terms and Conditions will entitle the Publisher to terminate each Customer's access pursuant to this Agreement, irrespective of whether the Paying Party has made any payment to the Publisher in respect thereof. In respect of an individual Customer breach, the termination and its consequences will only apply to the Customer in question and their share of the Charges will be deducted from the Charges.

The rights in this Clause are in addition to any rights and remedies that may be available in law or equity.

- 8.3 The Publisher reserves the right to withdraw from the Publications content which it has reasonable grounds to believe infringes copyright or is defamatory, obscene or unlawful without incurring any liability to the Consortium.

If the Publisher withdraws more than 5% of the total Journals listed Schedule E, then the Publisher shall make a pro rata refund/reduction of the Charges, taking into account the amount of Journals withdrawn and the remaining unexpired portion of the Subscription Period. For avoidance of doubt, titles described in Schedule C clause 4.2 are not considered withdrawn Journal.

- 8.4 Termination of this Agreement for whatever reason shall not affect the liabilities or obligations of the Publisher, National Library, and the Customers accruing up to the date of termination.

9 REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

- 9.1 The Publisher represents and warrants that it has the power to enter into this Agreement and to enter into the Customer agreements, including all schedules and that the Publications used as contemplated in this Agreement do not violate or infringe upon any patent, copyright, trademark, trade secret or other proprietary right or contract right of any third party and that Publisher will carry out its obligations hereunder with reasonable skill and care.

- 9.2 THE PUBLISHER GIVES NO WARRANTY TO THE NATIONAL LIBRARY EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AND MAKES NO REPRESENTATION THAT (I) THE PUBLICATIONS WILL BE SUITABLE FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR FOR ANY PARTICULAR USE UNDER SPECIFIED CONDITIONS, NOTWITHSTANDING THAT SUCH PURPOSE, USE, OR CONDITIONS MAY BE KNOWN TO THE PUBLISHER; NOR (II) THAT THE PUBLICATIONS WILL OPERATE ERROR FREE.

- 9.3 IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER FOR ANY LOSS RESULTING FROM A CAUSE OVER WHICH THE PARTY DOES NOT HAVE DIRECT CONTROL, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FAILURE OF ELECTRONIC OR MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT OR COMMUNICATION LINES, TELEPHONE OR OTHER INTERCONNECT PROBLEMS, UNAUTHORISED ACCESS, THEFT, OR OPERATOR ERRORS.

- 9.4 IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER FOR ANY CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR INDIRECT DAMAGES INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF DATA OR CORRUPTION OF DATA, LOSS OF PROGRAMS, LOSS OF BUSINESS OR GOODWILL, OR OTHER DAMAGES OR LOSSES OF ANY NATURE ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF, OR INABILITY TO USE THE PUBLICATIONS.

- 9.5 THE PARTIES AGREE THAT THE ENTIRE LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF ANY KIND OF LEGAL CLAIM (WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT, BY STATUTE OR OTHERWISE) IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH THE USE OR INABILITY TO USE THE LICENSED WORKS SHALL BE THE REFUND OF ANY CHARGES PAID TO THE PUBLISHER UNDER THIS AGREEMENT.

- 9.6 THE NATIONAL LIBRARY WARRANTS AND REPRESENTS TO THE PUBLISHER EACH OF THE CUSTOMERS IS PROVIDED WITH A COPY OF THIS AGREEMENT WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME AFTER THE AGREEMENT HAS BEEN MUTUALLY SIGNED.

10 TAX COMPLIANCE

- 10.1 Neither party shall in relation to this Agreement engage in any activity, practice or conduct which would constitute, or be regarded as, an offence under any law or regulation applicable to it, consisting of the fraudulent, or otherwise unlawful, evasion of any tax.

11 GENERAL

- 11.1 This Agreement is personal to the National Library and the respective Customers and neither this Agreement nor any of the rights or obligations under this Agreement may be assigned or sublicensed by the National Library or by any Customer without the prior written consent of the Publisher. The Publisher may assign any or all of its rights and obligations under this Agreement to an affiliate, a successor to its business or a transferee of Publisher's right to publish and distribute any Publication(s). The rights and obligations of this Agreement will bind and benefit any successors and permitted assigns of the Publisher, National Library, and the Customers. Any attempted assignment in violation of this Clause will be null and void and of no force or effect.
- 11.2 Where expressly stated, formal notices (including but not limited to legal documents) required to be given under this Agreement will be given in writing in English and left at or sent by first class registered or recorded delivery to the appropriate address shown at the head of this Agreement, or such other address as the party concerned may from time to time designate by notice pursuant to this Clause. Such notices will be deemed to be delivered (i) when left at the addressee's address; or (ii) if posted 10 (ten) days after posting. All formal notices to Publisher shall be marked for the attention of the Group Legal Director. All notices to the National Library shall be marked for the attention of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], The National Library of Finland, FinELib, P.O. Box 15 (Unioninkatu 36) 00014 University of Helsinki, Helsinki, Finland.
- 11.3 This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the Publisher, National Library, and the Customers about its subject matter, supersedes all prior communications, understandings and agreements (whether written or oral) relating to its subject matter and may not be amended or modified except by agreement in writing signed by both parties.
- 11.4 Subject to the requirements of any laws local to the Publisher, National Library and the Customer : this Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered will constitute a duplicate original, but all the counterparts will together constitute the one agreement; and the Publisher, National Library and Customer agree to be bound by photocopy, scanned, facsimile, electronic or other copies, which will have the same effect for all purposes as an ink-signed original.
- 11.5 This Agreement may be amended by agreement in writing executed by all parties.
- 11.6 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, neither the National Library, Customer nor the Publisher will be responsible to the other for any failure to perform any obligation under this Agreement due to Acts of God, war, riot, , acts of civil or military authorities, fire, flood, typhoon, wind storm, snow storm, blizzard, hurricane, or other cause that is outside the control of the party and could not be avoided by the exercise of due care. Notwithstanding the occurrence of any of the events set forth in this Clause, the Publisher, National Library, and the Customers shall at all times use reasonable efforts to perform all obligations under this Agreement in a timely manner, taking account of the existing circumstances.
- 11.7 No provision in this Agreement is intended to be enforceable by any third party.
- 11.8 The rights of the Publisher, National Library, and the Customers arising under this Agreement will not be waived except in writing. Any waiver of any of a party's rights under this Agreement or of any breach of this Agreement by the other party will not be construed as a waiver of any other rights or of any other further breach.
- 11.9 Headings used in this Agreement are for convenience only and are deemed not to be part of the Agreement.
- 11.10 This Agreement including all Schedules, Exhibits, and Annexes is not confidential and the Publisher acknowledges that the National Library and/or Customer is intending to publish the Agreement including all Schedules, provided that all personal data will be blacked out (otherwise known as redacted).

12 SANCTIONS

- 12.1 The Publisher confirms that it is currently not the subject or target of any sanctions imposed by the sanctions authority of the European Union or the United Nations and neither is any person or entity that is an owner of the Publisher or otherwise has control over the Publisher.
- 12.2 The Publisher will inform the National Library without delay if there is any change in the sanctions status of itself or the aforementioned person or entity. If there is a change in the aforementioned sanctions status the Customer has the right to terminate this Agreement with immediate effect and receive a pro-rated refund of any Fees paid.

13 DATA PROTECTION

- 13.1 If at any time during the Term the Commission implementing decision of 28 June 2021 pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the adequate protection of personal data by the United Kingdom is no longer in force, and agreement over entering into the European Commission standard contractual clauses (SCC controller to controller) cannot be reached, the Customer may terminate this Agreement with notice to the Publisher and receive a refund of any prepaid but unused Fees.

SCHEDULE A – CUSTOMER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT AND ANNEXES

- 1.1 All defined terms can be found in the National Library Terms and Conditions at Clause 2.
- 1.2 The terms in Annex 1 will apply for Journals Subscriptions. Such Journals Subscriptions are specified in Schedule E (as may be amended from time to time).
- 1.3 The terms of Schedule C will apply in respect of the publication of OA Articles.

2. GRANT OF ACCESS, PERMITTED USE AND LIMITATIONS ON USE

- 2.1 In the event that any content included in the Publications has been issued under a Creative Commons licence or other open access license, the Authorised Users shall have the right to access and use that content in accordance with the relevant Creative Commons licence or other open license, where applicable.
- 2.2 For each Publication, respectively, during the relevant Subscription Period, the Customer may allow its Authorised Users, on a non-exclusive and non-transferable basis (and in all cases subject to the remaining terms and conditions of these Customer Terms and Conditions, including the restrictions listed in Clause 2.3 below), for Educational Purposes, and for administrative purposes to:
 - 2.2.1 access the Server by means of a Secure Network to search the Publication and to view, retrieve, and display portions thereof;
 - 2.2.2 save and print out single copies of portions of the Publication;
 - 2.2.3 make a reasonable number of photocopies of parts of the Publications;
 - 2.2.4 provide single printed or electronic copies of portions of the Publications to other Authorised Users;
 - 2.2.5 incorporate links to the Publication in electronic course packs and course management systems for use in connection with courses offered by the Customer for academic credit;
 - 2.2.6 transmit links to single journal articles to other Authorised Users;
 - 2.2.7 the Customer may supply another academic library or library which is part of a non-commercial organisation, on a non-exclusive basis and for the sole purpose of supplying an authorised patron of the recipient library with a single copy of an electronic original of an individual document from a Publication for that patron's research or private study (and not for Commercial Use), provided that:
 - 2.2.7.1 such copy is provided in response to the recipient library's request therefor;
 - 2.2.7.2 if the Customer charges the recipient library for such copy, then the sum charged is calculated by reference to the costs attributable to the production of the copy;such supply is by post, fax or secure electronic transmission using Ariel or its equivalent, whereby the electronic file is deleted and inaccessible after printing provided that where supply by secure electronic transmission is not available, the supply may be by email to a recipient library within Finland provided further that any such email is not forwarded to individual users; and
 - 2.2.8 distribute single copies of single articles, or parts thereof, of the Publications in print or electronic form to third party colleagues for the purposes of non-commercial scientific research and communication or to be used for the basis of discussion groups. This sharing shall be incidental and not for re-transmission;

- 2.2.9 publicly display or publicly perform parts of the Publications as part of a presentation at a seminar, conference, or workshop, or other such similar activity, provided any such display or performance is accompanied by a sufficient acknowledgement, and any printed or electronic copies of such presentations are not otherwise distributed to any person other than an Authorised User;
- 2.2.10 extract and use excerpts from the Publications for Educational Purposes, including extraction and manipulation for the purpose of illustration, explanation, example, comment, criticism, teaching, research, and analysis;
- 2.2.11 use, with appropriate credit, figures, tables, and brief excerpts from the Publications in the Authorised User's own scientific, scholarly, and educational works including but not limited to books and articles;
- 2.2.12 search the Publications via the Retrieval Portal or other portal in the Customer's use provided that the terms of this Agreement are upheld;
- 2.2.13 gather usage data via the Retrieval Portal or other information retrieval portal in the Customer's use;
- 2.2.14 display, save electronically, print and distribute reasonable, single portions of the Publications including trademarks, logos and screenshots (as such trademarks and logos are incorporated in the Publications) to Authorised Users via the Secure Network for the purpose of promotion or testing or for training Authorised Users;
- 2.2.15 Customer may copy and/or download metadata of the Publications and/or portions of Publications and make it perpetually available without charge in the following internal or publicly available online systems in Customer's use:
 - 1.library catalogue(s)
 - 2. information search portal(s) and systems (including but not limited to the national Finna, sector specific or geographical Finnas)
 - 3. national metadata repository Melinda
 - 4. institutional repositories
 - 5. research publications portal(s) including national portals
 - 6.institutional research information systems (CRIS) including national systems

Only metadata regarding articles authored or co-authored by the Customer's faculty, students, staff or affiliated researchers may be used for institutional repositories, research publications portals and institutional research information systems.
- 2.2.16 This Agreement shall be deemed to complement and extend the rights of the Customers and Authorised Users under the Finnish Copyright Act (404/1961) ("Act") and EC Copyright Directive (2001/29/EC) ("Directive") and nothing in this Agreement shall constitute a waiver of any statutory rights held by the Customers or Authorised Users from time to time under the Act and the Directive or any amending legislation.
- 2.3 Provided that nothing in these Customer Terms and Conditions will limit the Customer's or an Authorised Users' rights under applicable copyright laws, (and save as provided elsewhere in this Agreement) the Customer and its Authorised Users may not:
 - 2.3.1 remove or alter Publisher's copyright notices or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Publications;

- 2.3.2 systematically make multiple printed or electronic copies of portions of the Publications for any purpose except as permitted by law or as authorised by Publisher;
 - 2.3.3 display or distribute or permit access to any part of the Publications via any method other than the Secure Network;
 - 2.3.4 permit anyone other than Authorised Users to access or use the Publications; and
 - 2.3.5 use all or any part of the Publications for any Commercial Use.
- 2.4 In the case of any conflict or ambiguity between the Permitted Use specified in this Clause 2 and the Permitted Use specified in the legal notice for any Publication, this Clause 2 will take precedence in respect of that Publication.

3. ACCESS AND SECURITY

- 3.1 The Customer will provide through the Consortium acting on its behalf a list of valid IP addresses to the Publisher necessary to enable the Publisher to set up and activate the Customer's subscription to the Publications, and update those lists as and when any IP addresses are updated. For avoidance of doubt, the IP addresses and any updates to them will be provided directly from the Consortium to the Publisher and neither the Customer nor the Consortium will be required to use the services of any other third party to do this.
- 3.2 The Customer will obtain and maintain during the term of these Customer Terms and Conditions at its cost all telecommunications and other equipment and software (including relevant licenses) needed to access the Publications online via the Customer's Secure Network.
- 3.3 The Customer shall:
- 3.3.1 use reasonable efforts to ensure that only Authorised Users are permitted access to the Publications by means of the Customer's Secure Network; and
 - 3.3.2 use reasonable efforts to notify Authorised Users of the permitted and prohibited uses
- 3.4 The Customer will notify Publisher as soon as practicable if it becomes aware of any of the following: (a) any unauthorised use of any of the Password(s); and (b) any breach by an Authorised User of the terms of this Agreement (and the circumstances surrounding any unauthorised use or breach shall be included in such notification); and (c) on becoming aware of any claim by any third party that the Publications infringes an intellectual property or proprietary right of any third party.
- 3.5 Upon becoming aware of any breach of the terms of this Agreement by an Authorised User, the Customer shall promptly initiate disciplinary procedures in accordance with the Customer's standard practice.
- 3.6 The Publisher reserves the right to suspend access to the Publications and/or the OA Account in the event of late payment of the Charges by the National Library and the National Library fails to pay the same within 30 (thirty) days of being given written notice to do so by the Publisher. The Publisher reserves the right to suspend access to the Publications in the event of any unauthorised use of the Publications. As far as is reasonably possible, the Publisher shall exercise the right to suspend in a manner that is appropriate to the unauthorised use, and the Publisher will aim to limit suspension to the offending ip-address where this is reasonably and practically possible. For the avoidance of doubt any such denial of access will not entitle the Customer to any rebate of Charges.
- 3.7 The Customer shall not be held liable for breach of this Agreement by an Authorised User provided that the Customer did not cause, knowingly assist, or condone the continuation of such breach after becoming aware of an actual breach having occurred.
- 3.8 For the avoidance of doubt, each Customer will only be liable for its own actions and/or defaults.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF PUBLISHER

- 4.1 The Publisher shall use all reasonable efforts:
 - 4.1.1 to make each Publication available online to the Customer throughout the Subscription Period;
 - 4.1.2 to ensure that the Server has sufficient capacity and rate of connectivity to provide the Customer with a quality of service consistent with current industry standards for publishers publishing materials online;
 - 4.1.3 to restore the Customer's access to the Publications as soon as possible in the event of an interruption or suspension of the service; and
 - 4.1.4 to provide, or arrange for a third party to provide, customer support services to Authorised Users.
- 4.2 The Publisher agrees to publish OA Articles in accordance with the terms and conditions of Schedule C.
- 4.3 The Publisher will use best efforts to provide the Publications with a quality of service consistent with industry standards, specifically to provide continuous service with a minimum of 96% up-time per subscription, with a maximum 4% down-time including scheduled maintenance and repairs performed at a time to minimise inconvenience to the Customer and its Authorised Users and restore the service as soon as possible in the event of an interruption or suspension of service. For the avoidance of doubt, unexpected maintenance may occur and the Publisher endeavours to inform the Customer as soon as possible in such circumstance. If there is less than 96% up time calculated at the end of each year of the Subscription Period the Publisher shall offer the Customer a pro-rated refund of the Charges related to the Publication(s) which were affected by the downtime. Such refund may be reflected on the invoice relating to the Charges payable for the following year period where such option is available.
- 4.4 The Publisher will make available to the Customer monthly usage reports throughout the Subscription Period for each Publication, detailing the level of use of each Publication by the Customer's Authorised Users per month. The Publisher confirms that the usage reports are COUNTER compliant at the start of the Subscription Period. The Publisher shall use reasonable efforts to ensure that such usage reports are compliant with the most recent release of the COUNTER Code of Practice for Journals and Databases (available at <https://cop5.projectcounter.org/en/5.0.2>). If any usage reports are not made available due to a failure by the party providing such reports on behalf of the Publisher, the Publisher shall use its best efforts to resolve the failure as quickly as possible. The Customer acknowledges that the Publisher will not be able to provide accurate usage reports if the Customer stores the Publication(s) on any cache or proxy server.
- 4.5 The Publisher shall provide web based user training.
- 4.6 The Publisher is committed to complying with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) (<https://www.w3.org/WAI/standards-guidelines/wcag/>) in order to ensure that the Publications is accessible to all Authorised Users of the Customer.
- 4.7 The Publisher shall adhere to the specifications of the Transfer Code of Practice (<http://www.uksg.org/transfer/code>).
- 4.8 Use its best endeavours to ensure that the Publications will be compatible with standard search interfaces (e.g. Z39.50, SRU/SRW) for the term of the Agreement.
- 4.9 Use its best endeavours to ensure the Publications will meet the openURL standard for the Term of the Agreement.
- 4.10 The Publisher shall use its best endeavours to adhere to the specifications of the KBART standards (<http://www.uksg.org/kbart/s5/guidelines>).

- 4.11 The Publisher shall provide to the National Library, upon request by the National Library, before December 31 of each year within the Subscription Period, in KBART-compliant format, an itemized holdings report that specifies the Publications accessible to each Customer as well as Eligible Journals for the upcoming calendar year.
- 4.12 Implement the Standardized Usage Statistics Harvesting Initiative (SUSHI) protocol (www.niso.org/workrooms/sushi);
- 4.13 The Publisher agrees to make the data relating to the Publications available to Customer's discovery service system provider Ex Libris. The Publisher and the Customers acknowledge that Ex Libris make the data available through affiliated discovery systems (such as Central Discovery Index) and linking services for indexing and discovery purposes. The Publisher also supports Alma link resolvers.

5. PAYMENT OF THE CHARGES

- 5.1 In consideration of the Publisher entering into the Customer agreements with each Customer through the National Library representing each Customer via a power of attorney, the Paying Party shall pay the Charges due to the Publisher as set out in Schedule B in each year of the Term within 60 days of receipt of each appropriate invoice. For Journals, the Publisher will invoice the National Library using separate invoices: one invoice relating to access to the Journals (i.e. 'read'); and one relating to publication of OA Articles (i.e. 'publish'). The Publisher's allocation of the Charges between 'read' and 'publish' is set out in Schedule B and is based on the Customers' subscription spend and estimated article publishing output. Such allocation may be subject to rounding up variations to a maximum of €10 (ten euros) as may be necessary due to the functionality of the Publisher's management system. Such invoices shall contain:

- 5.2 *Where the Paying Party is the National Library:* the National Library agrees to pay the Publisher the Charges irrespective of whether the National Library collects any payment from any/all of the Customers. If the National Library fails to pay such sums to the Publisher, the Publisher may suspend access to any or all Publications or any portion thereof and/or the OA Account or may terminate this Agreement without liability to the National Library or to any Customer, and the National Library and Customers, respectively, agree that the sole remedy in such circumstances would be the Customers' remedies against the National Library and not the Publisher. The Publisher's rights specified in this Clause are in addition to any rights and remedies that may be available in law or equity.
- 5.3 Subject to 4.5.2 of the National Library Terms and Conditions, the Publisher will not be obliged to grant access to a Publication, or continue to grant access to a given Customer, if the relevant Charges have not been paid in accordance with Clause 5.1 above.
- 5.4 Unless expressly stated to the contrary in this Agreement, all amounts referred to in this Agreement shall be interpreted as being amounts exclusive of value added tax. The National Library is responsible for payment of any value added tax payable to the Finnish tax authority. The National Library shall pay all amounts due to the Publisher without any deduction and/or withholding other than such amount (if any) it is required to deduct and/or withhold by law and/or upon other direction of any tax authority. In the event the National Library is required to make such deduction and/or withholding, the National Library shall notify the Publisher promptly on becoming aware of such requirement.

6. ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND PROTECTION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- 6.1 The Customer acknowledges that, as between the Publisher and the Customer, all copyrights, patent rights, trademarks, services marks, database rights, trade secrets and other intellectual property rights relating to the Publications, and the Publisher's trademarks OXFORD, and OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS (collectively the "Publisher Intellectual Property"), are owned or controlled by or licensed to the Publisher, and the Customer further acknowledges that this Agreement does not convey to the Customer any right, title, or interest therein except for the right to access and use, and permit its Authorised Users to access and use, the Publications in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- 6.2 The Customer acknowledges that neither it nor any of its Authorised Users may create any derivative work based on the Publications without the prior written permission of the Publisher. or unless permitted based on applicable copyright law.

7. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

- 7.1 PUBLISHER REPRESENTS AND WARRANTS THAT IT HAS THE POWER TO ENTER INTO THIS AGREEMENT AND TO GRANT THE RIGHTS CONFERRED HEREIN TO THE CUSTOMER AND THAT THE PUBLICATIONS USED AS PERMITTED IN THIS AGREEMENT DO NOT VIOLATE OR INFRINGE UPON ANY PATENT, COPYRIGHT, TRADEMARK, TRADE SECRET OR OTHER PROPRIETARY RIGHT OR CONTRACT RIGHT OF ANY THIRD PARTY.
- 7.2 SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE, PUBLISHER GIVES NO WARRANTY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AND MAKES NO REPRESENTATION THAT (I) THE PUBLICATIONS WILL BE OF SATISFACTORY QUALITY, SUITABLE FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR FOR ANY PARTICULAR USE UNDER SPECIFIED CONDITIONS, NOTWITHSTANDING THAT SUCH PURPOSE, USE, OR CONDITIONS MAY BE KNOWN TO PUBLISHER; OR (II) THAT THE PUBLICATIONS WILL OPERATE ERROR FREE OR WITHOUT INTERRUPTION OR THAT ANY ERRORS WILL BE CORRECTED; OR (III) THAT THE MATERIAL PUBLISHED IN THE PUBLICATIONS IS EITHER COMPLETE OR ACCURATE.
- 7.3 IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER FOR ANY LOSS RESULTING FROM A CAUSE OVER WHICH PUBLISHER DOES NOT HAVE DIRECT CONTROL, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FAILURE OF ELECTRONIC OR MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT OR COMMUNICATION LINES, TELEPHONE OR OTHER INTERCONNECT PROBLEMS, UNAUTHORISED ACCESS, THEFT, OR OPERATOR ERRORS.
- 7.4 SAVE AS PROVIDED IN CLAUSE 7.7. IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER FOR ANY CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR INDIRECT DAMAGES OR LOSS OF PROFITS INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF DATA OR CORRUPTION OF DATA, LOSS OF PROGRAMS, LOSS OF BUSINESS OR GOODWILL, OR OTHER DAMAGES OR LOSSES OF ANY NATURE ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF, OR INABILITY TO USE THE PUBLICATIONS.
- 7.5 SAVE AS PROVIDED IN CLAUSE 7.7 THE PARTIES AGREE THAT THE ENTIRE LIABILITY OF EITHER PARTY ARISING OUT OF ANY KIND OF LEGAL CLAIM (WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT, BY STATUTE OR OTHERWISE) IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH THE USE OR INABILITY TO USE THE PUBLICATIONS SHALL BE THE REFUND OF ANY CHARGES PAID UNDER THIS AGREEMENT DURING THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD IN WHICH THE CLAIM ARISES.
- 7.6 THE PUBLISHER WARRANTS AND REPRESENTS TO THE CUSTOMER THAT THE PUBLICATIONS AND ALL INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS THEREIN ARE OWNED BY OR LICENSED TO THE PUBLISHER AND THAT THE PUBLICATIONS USED AS CONTEMPLATED IN THIS AGREEMENT DOES NOT INFRINGE ANY INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS OF ANY NATURAL OR LEGAL PERSON.

- 7.7 PUBLISHER SHALL DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD THE CUSTOMER HARMLESS AGAINST ALL CLAIMS, SUITS, PROCEEDINGS, LOSSES, LIABILITIES, AND DAMAGES (INCLUDING COSTS, EXPENSES, AND REASONABLE ATTORNEY'S FEES) ASSERTED BY THIRD PARTIES AGAINST THE CUSTOMER WHICH ARISE OUT OF ANY ACT OR OMISSION BY THE PUBLISHER THAT CONSTITUTES A BREACH OF THE PUBLISHER'S WARRANTIES HEREUNDER. THIS INDEMNITY SHALL NOT APPLY IF THE CUSTOMER HAS USED THE PUBLICATIONS IN ANY WAY NOT PERMITTED BY THIS AGREEMENT, AND SUCH USE HAS CAUSED THE LOSS, DAMAGE, COST, LIABILITY OR EXPENSE. THIS INDEMNITY IS CONDITIONAL ON THE CUSTOMER; (A) AS SOON AS REASONABLY PRACTICAL, GIVE WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE CLAIM TO THE PUBLISHER, SPECIFYING THE NATURE OF THE CLAIM IN REASONABLE DETAIL; (B) NOT MAKING ANY ADMISSION OF LIABILITY AGREEMENT OR COMPROMISE IN RELATION TO THE CLAIM WITHOUT THE PRIOR WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE PUBLISHER; (C) GIVING THE PUBLISHER AND ITS PROFESSIONAL ADVISERS ACCESS AT REASONABLE TIMES (ON REASONABLE PRIOR NOTICE) TO ITS PREMISES AND ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, REPRESENTATIVES OR ADVISERS, AND TO ANY RELEVANT ASSETS, ACCOUNTS, DOCUMENTS AND RECORDS WITHIN THE POWER OF CONTROL OF THE CUSTOMER AS SO TO ENABLE THE PUBLISHER AND ITS PROFESSIONAL ADVISERS TO EXAMINE THEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSESSING THE CLAIM AND; (D) GIVING TO THE PUBLISHER SOLE AUTHORITY TO AVOID, DISPUTE, COMPROMISE OR DEFEND THE CLAIM. NO LIMITATION OF LIABILITIES APPLIES.

ANNEX 1 – ADDITIONAL TERMS FOR A JOURNALS SUBSCRIPTION

1. The terms in this Annex will apply only in relation to a Journals Subscription, if any, access to which is purchased by or on behalf of the Customer pursuant to an agreement with the Publisher.
2. Notwithstanding the expiry of the Subscription Period the Customer shall be entitled to continuing access to (i) the content within the Publications that were published for the first time during the Subscription Period as applicable per each Customer on the same terms as these Customer Terms and Conditions, and (ii) any content within journals that were purchased on a perpetual access basis under previous agreements as applicable per Customer on the terms and conditions of such previous agreements, except that the provisions set out in Clauses 2, 3, and 4 in the above Customer Terms and Conditions shall apply to such previously purchased Journals and will take priority over any conflicting terms in such previous agreements, and provided in each case of (i) and (ii) that the Customer shall pay any relevant Hosting Fees (following the procedure set out in Clause 5 of this Annex) but only if the Customer no longer holds any current journals or other product subscription with the Publisher. Subject to Clause 3 below, such continuing access will be provided via the Publisher's Server.
3. If the Publisher ceases to hold the publication rights to any of the Journals, and is no longer able to provide the access thereto described in Clause 2 of this Annex, the Publisher shall ensure that continuing access is provided:
 - a. by the new publisher of the relevant Journal(s); or
 - b. through Portico or a similar 3rd party archive and in such case the Publisher shall provide all relevant details of the Customer to the 3rd party in order to enable access to the 3rd party archive by the Customer; provided that such access will be subject to Customer fulfilling the 3rd party's terms and condition for access; or
 - c. by providing the Customer with an electronic copy of the relevant Publications for the purpose of local hosting by the Customer in an electronic medium which conforms to normal industry standards and is mutually agreed between the parties which will be delivered to the Customer or to a central archiving facility operated on behalf of the Customer, and which mounting and access to such archival copies shall be in accordance with clause 4 below.
4. In relation to the archival copies of the Publications received by the Customer in accordance with clause 3.c above, the Customer is permitted to mount the archival copies of the Publications supplied by the Publisher, communicate, make available and provide access to such Publications via a Secure Network to Authorised Users only, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. The Customer is further permitted to re-format the Publications contained in the archival copies supplied by the Publisher in any way to ensure their future preservation and accessibility in accordance with this Agreement.
5. The provisions relating to hosting services are as follows:
 - a. The Publisher shall calculate the Hosting Fees payable for hosting services on the basis of a rolling twelve (12) month period or such other hosting period as may be specified by the Publisher.
 - b. No later than sixty (60) days before the end of any current hosting period, the Publisher may send the Customer an invoice for the Hosting Fees for renewal of such hosting services for a further twelve (12) month period. These Hosting Fees may be higher than the Hosting Fees for the then current hosting period. If the Customer does not pay the Hosting Fees the Publisher may terminate such hosting services on written notice to the Customer.
 - c. If the Publisher does not wish to continue hosting all or any of the Journals, whether due to ceasing publication of the Journal in question or otherwise, it shall give the Customer not less than ninety (90) days' notice of the termination of such hosting services and shall credit the Customer all Hosting Fees applicable to the unexpired term of the then current hosting period on a pro rata basis.

- d. No Hosting Fees shall be charged while the Customer has a current subscription to any Journal or other online product published by the Publisher.

The Charges for 2025 shall be calculated as follows:

The Charges for Customers who do not upgrade to the 2025 full Journals collection shall remain the same as 2024, and such Customers shall not have access to any Journals joining the Publisher as of 01 January 2025.

The Charges for Customers who do upgrade to the 2025 full Journals collection shall be the 2024 Charges plus:

- (a) 5% of the online list price (representing a 95% discount) for each Journal (i) transitioning from another publisher and/or (ii) joining the 2025 full Journals collection; and
- (b) the online list price for each Journal (i) transitioning from another publisher and/or (ii) joining the 2025 full Journals collection that the Customer previously subscribed to.

SCHEDULE C

OPEN ACCESS PUBLISHING

Under this Schedule C, the Publisher and the Customer intend to establish a legal and economic framework to allow authors from the Customer to have articles published on an open access basis in certain journals as part of the agreement between Oxford University Press and the Customer, as further described in this Schedule C.

All defined terms can be found in the National Library Terms and Conditions at Clause 2.

1. WORKFLOW/CHARGE REQUESTS AND USE OF OA ARTICLE ALLOWANCE

- 1.1. The workflow for Eligible Authors is set out in the OA Account Process at Appendix 1 together with the Author Guide at Appendix 2.
- 1.2. Eligible Authors whose Eligible Articles are accepted for publication by the Publisher will be required to choose an OA Licence with the Publisher in order to make a Charge Request. Such Eligible Authors will be presented with the option to select Creative Commons Attribution or the latest version of said license (“CC BY”) as the first open access license option (where such license is available, and regardless of the Eligible Author’s funder). The Publisher will use its best efforts to ensure that Eligible Authors are provided information about the licensing preference (being CC BY) of the Customer with whom they have declared to be affiliated.
- 1.3. In each calendar year of the Agreement the National Library and/or Customer may approve Charge Requests up to the OA Article Allowance for each such year as indicated in Clause 4 of this Schedule C.
- 1.4. The National Library and/or Customer shall review and exercise its right to approve or reject all Charge Requests. The Customer’s Charge Request Approval process is set out in the Account Holder Guide to Approving at Appendix 3. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the National Library will act as the account administrator for each Customer until such time when each Customer’s view is limited to their institution/Ringgold IDs.
- 1.5. The Publisher reserves the right to reject Charge Requests that have not been accepted within 7 calendar days after the date of the Charge Request.
- 1.6. The National Library and/or Customer acknowledges that (i) it is solely responsible for verifying that an Eligible Author is affiliated with the Customer (ii) any information relating to the affiliation of an Eligible Author to a Customer provided by the Publisher to the National Library and/or Customer will be based on the information as provided by the Eligible Author, and (iii) Publisher will not under any circumstances be responsible for verifying the identity of any Eligible Author or the validity of any Charge Request made by any Eligible Author.
- 1.7. Publisher and the National Library will review the verification process as set forth herein on regular basis during the duration of the Agreement and will work collaboratively to address any workflow issues that have been identified.
- 1.8. The OA Article Allowance is intended to be for Eligible Articles (a list of such peer reviewed article types has been provided by the Publisher and may be updated from time to time if necessary by the Publisher) in Hybrid Eligible Journals, but the parties acknowledge that the Publisher may be unable to stop other types of articles from being referred. For the avoidance of doubt, if Charge Requests are approved for such other types of articles, such approval will not be considered a breach of this Agreement.

2. PUBLICATION

- 2.1. OA Articles will be published online under the terms of the relevant OA Licence. Publisher will clearly indicate the OA Articles that are available on an open access basis in the Eligible Journals and clearly mark the Creative Commons license in the article.

- 2.2. Eligible Authors (or their employer or funder as may be applicable) will retain copyright to their OA Articles for those Journals that allow for this (as identified in Schedule E).
- 2.3. Following publication of an OA Article, the Publisher will deliver the article metadata including OA Licence information to Crossref and other relevant third parties.
- 2.4. Publisher shall deposit OA Articles in Portico, CLOCKSS, or a similar third party archive.
- 2.5. Where any Eligible Articles which were Received Into Production in Eligible Journals during the Term were not published on an open access basis, the Publisher shall convert such articles to OA Articles with a CC BY licence (where the Eligible Journal offers this licence) via the OA Account, unless the Eligible Author opts out of making such article open access.
- 2.6. Provided that the Journal offers CC BY, should the National Library or the Customer request that the licence of an Eligible Article be changed from another Creative Commons licence to CC BY, the Publisher shall arrange for such change accordingly, unless the Eligible Author opts out.
- 2.7. If the Publisher is notified that an invoice has been raised for publication of an Eligible Article and such invoice has not been paid, then such invoice will be cancelled. The Charge Request for such Eligible Article will then be reviewed by the Customer in accordance with Clause 1.4 above. If such Charge Request is rejected by the Customer, the invoice for the publication of the Eligible Article shall be re-raised. For the avoidance of doubt, any invoices that have been paid shall not be refunded, unless the Publisher is notified within 30 days of payment of such relevant invoice.

3. REPORTING

- 3.1. Unless otherwise agreed between the parties, the Publisher will provide, twice per calendar year of the Agreement, on a schedule to be agreed between the parties, a report of articles by Eligible Authors which have been Received Into Production over the period of 12 months prior to the date of such report. Each report shall include the following information:
 - 3.1.1. name of the Eligible Author, with its email address and ORCID, as provided by the Eligible Author on submission of the article;
 - 3.1.2. name of the Customer based on information provided by the Eligible Author;
 - 3.1.3. article title;
 - 3.1.4. article type;
 - 3.1.5. Received Into Production date;
 - 3.1.6. OA Licence selected by the Eligible Author;
 - 3.1.7. Eligible journal title;
 - 3.1.8. Eligible journal ISSN; and
 - 3.1.9. DOI.
- 3.2. The National Library also has real time access to the information listed in 3.1. through the OA Account dashboard.
- 3.3. The Publisher shall also provide the National Library with a list of Eligible Articles where the Eligible Author selected to publish either (i) on a subscription basis, or (ii) open access under a CC BY-NC or CC BY-NC-ND licence where a CC BY licence was available at the time of such selection, or (iii) open access where the author or the author's institution paid the article processing charge outside of this Agreement. Such list shall be provided once per quarter.

4. OA ARTICLE ALLOWANCE

- 4.1. The Publisher shall make available to the Customers the following OA Article Allowance in the following periods (for clarity, the OA Article Allowance is an aggregate amount for use by all the Customers):

Year 1 2024	unlimited
Year 2 2025	unlimited

- 4.2. Any Eligible Hybrid Journal that becomes a Fully OA Journal during the Term shall remain an Eligible Journal for use of Article Allowance for the remainder of the Term.
- 4.3. From the date of signature the publisher agrees to provide authors who are affiliated with the Customer (as identified using RinggoldID(s)) with a 15% discount against the then current open access charges in the Publisher's Fully OA Journals. Such discount may only be applied if the author complies with the Publisher's process for enabling such discounts. Authors must provide their institutional affiliation when they submit their article to the Fully OA Journal. The 15% discount may not be used in conjunction with any other discount. Payment of these charges is not covered through this Agreement and the author(s) of each article will be responsible for arranging payment. For the avoidance of doubt, the 15% discount will not be applicable for articles in Eligible Hybrid Journals which become Fully OA Journals during the Term as per Clause 4.2 above.

5. EDITORIAL INDEPENDENCE

- 5.1. Both parties recognise that neither the National Library nor the Customer will be involved in the editorial processes governing the publication of OA Articles.
- 5.2. The Publisher is not obligated to accept or publish any article submitted to the Publisher by an Eligible Author on the basis of this Agreement. The National Library and Customer recognise that the selection of content that is published on the Publisher's platform is entirely at the Publisher's discretion.
- 5.3. The National Library and Customer relinquish all possibly due claims towards the Publisher resulting from the Publisher's decisions in good faith to publish content, either entirely or partially, submitted by an Eligible Author.

6. RESPONSIBILITIES

- 6.1. The Customer shall comply with the Publisher's OA Account Process.
- 6.2. The Publisher will issue to the National Library and/or to each Customer, a unique username and Password to access the OA Account. The National Library and/or each Customer shall, and procures that any persons authorised to access the OA Account shall, at all times, keep the OA Account username and Password secure and must not permit any third party to use or have access to the OA Account username and Password. The National Library and/or the Customer shall notify Publisher as soon as possible if the National Library and/or the Customer suspects that any third party has obtained access to the OA Account username and Password and Publisher will invalidate that Password following receipt of such notice. Publisher reserves the right at any time to invalidate an OA Account username or Password if security may have been compromised. Any instruction, notice, acceptance or rejection of Charge Requests or other communications made by any person using the OA Account username with the correct and valid Password will be deemed to be authorised by the Customer. Publisher will not seek to verify the IP address from which the OA Account is accessed.
- 6.3. The National Library and Customer each warrant, represents and undertakes to Publisher that for itself:

- 6.3.1. all persons accessing and managing the OA Account are the National Library's or the Customer's employees duly authorised by the National Library or the Customer, and all instructions, notices and other communications made by any such person under this Schedule C are within the authority of that person; and
- 6.3.2. the National Library and/or the Customer has notified each person permitted to access the OA Account in accordance with this Schedule C, that such access to and use of the OA Account, is subject to the terms and conditions of this Schedule C and the Publisher's OA Account Process.
- 6.4. The National Library or Customer may authorise any of its employees to access and manage the OA Account Dashboard using the OA Account user name and Password assigned to the National Library/Customer in accordance with the procedure set out in this Schedule C.
- 6.5. The National Library acknowledges that the Publisher may make changes to the administration of the OA Account Process and the process for articles published in Fully OA Journals referred to in clause 4.3 above to ensure continued delivery of service and/or improvement of service.

7. DATA PROTECTION

- 7.1. The Parties confirm any data processing in respect of this Schedule will be in compliance with the Regulation (Eu) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council ("GDPR").
- 7.2. If such personal data is transferred out of the EEA the parties also agree to ensure a valid transfer mechanism in compliance with GDPR is in place.

APPENDIX 1: OA ACCOUNT PROCESS

OA Account Process

Account administrators

- An account administrator is someone who is nominated to have access to the Read and Publish account for agreement administration purposes (e.g. someone from a participating institution and/or consortium).
- Account administrators will be provided with a link to the online portal.
- Each account administrator will be linked to the RingGold ID(s) for the relevant institution or consortium.
- Account administrators will be informed of requests to use funds by authors whose institutional affiliation matches the associated RingGold ID(s).
- If a consortium or institution has a central account administrator, this account administrator can be set up with appropriate RingGold IDs for all participating institutions and will be informed of requests to use funds by authors across the consortium/institution.
- Each account administrator will be able to approve/reject requests for which they receive email communications.

Activating the account

- The account will be activated by OUP after the relevant invoice(s) have been sent to the Customer

Author workflow

- Authors will be required to provide their accurate institutional affiliation at the point of article submission to the journal.
- The article will go through peer-review, and if accepted the author will receive an email inviting them to access the SciPris portal.
- Authors of eligible articles who are affiliated with participating institutions (as identified using Ringgold ID(s)) will be directed to the Read and Publish workflow.
- The author agrees their license to publish their article and submits a request to use the Read and Publish agreement.

Approval process

- Account administrators will receive an email when there is a new charge request and can then log in to the SciPris portal to review the request details, before approving or declining the request.
 - o If the request is ineligible, a reason can be provided which will be sent to the author. The author will then need to make alternative arrangements for paying the APC.
 - o If the request is approved, the account administrator approves in the system and can see the remaining article allowance balance.

- The article allowance can be monitored in the account dashboard.
- Account administrators will be able to view records for the entire agreement (i.e. their view will not be limited to their institution/Ringgold IDs).


